After Moses broke the first set of the tablets of the Ten Commandments, what happened to the shattered pieces? The Torah does not mention where these holy shards went. This question led the rabbis to ponder the role that the broken tablets still played after the receiving of the second set of (unbroken) tablets. Through looking at teachings surrounding the two sets of tablets, we will learn that the whole and the broken were both considered sacred.

Rabbi Stiefel received her Rabbinic Ordination from the Reconstructionist Rabbinical College and a Masters in Social Work from the University of Pennsylvania. She has spent most of her career serving students on University campuses, and has worked in congregational and JCC settings as well.
