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#### SUMMER/CAMP SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Parents or guardians must be members in good standing at Temple of Aaron when funds are scheduled to be disbursed.
- Child must have been confirmed or regularly attending Temple of Aaron's Rabbi Bernard S. Raskas Religious School or another approved Jewish educational program.
- 3. Child must be a dues paying member of Temple of Aaron Youth Department to qualify for funding.
- 4. Avodah requirements must be done by June in order to get funding.
- 5. As funds are limited please know that you may not receive all money asked for. All applicants who meet the requirements are awarded scholarships
- 6. A letter of explanation must accompany this application should special circumstances exist.
- 7. Applications must be accompanied by an essay, 100 words or less on "How this Jewish experience will shape me".
- 8. The Scholarship Committee meets in February to allocate funds for programs. Notification of awards will be in letter/e-mail form the week following the meeting.
- 9. If in category with Avodah requirements, please make arrangements with Director of Education concerning those hours.
